This guide explains how to **select an artist** and **apply for an ArtistsInspire School Grant** using the updated grants system.


Step 1 - Access the Artist Directory




Step 3 - Complete the School Application Form

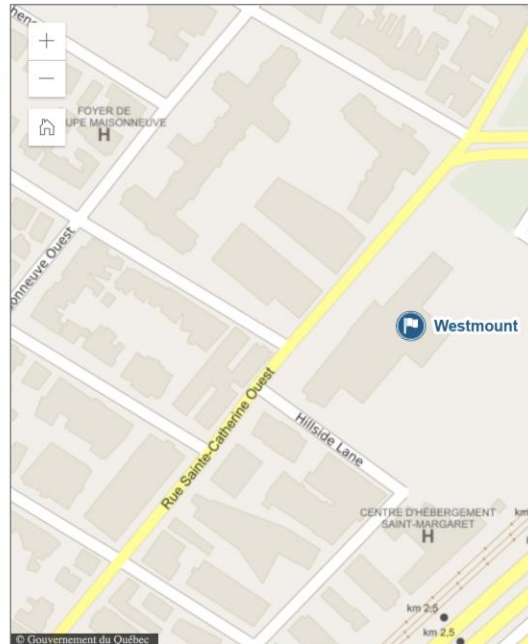
