

ArtistsInspire Grant Priority Framework

ArtistsInspire Grants receives more eligible applications than available funding each year. To promote fairness and equitable access across Quebec, applications are reviewed using the following priorities:

1. New Schools First

Priority is given to schools that did not receive an ArtistsInspire Grant during the previous school year.

2. One Project Per School

Priority is generally given to one eligible project per school before additional projects from the same school are considered.

3. Artist Opportunity Sharing

Priority is given to artists who have not yet received an ArtistsInspire Grant opportunity during the current funding cycle before additional projects for returning artists are considered.

4. Geographic & Community Equity

Priority may also be given to projects that increase access to arts programming in rural, remote, underserved, or historically underrepresented English-language communities.

5. Fair Access Across Funding Cycles

Schools may apply every year; however, priority is given to schools that did not receive funding during the previous funding cycle.

Please note: Meeting one or more priority criteria does not guarantee funding. All applications remain subject to program eligibility, available funding, and program review.
